

Things To Bring on The First Day Of School


- Small Bag








This will be given out to all P1 children on the first day of school, 2 Jan 2025 (Thu).





 - 5 Creates a learning environment that welcomes play, exploration and teamwork



- Enhance connections and promote bonding between parents, school and children.




